Need to find a book on adult ADHD? Use the **Simple Search** in NRC's online Library database. Type in **adult** in the **Any Word** box, and **book** in the **Record Type** box.

How about articles on executive functions that have appeared in Attention magazine? Use the **Advanced Search** and type in **executive functions** in the **Subject** box and **=Attention** in the **Journal Name** box. Sort the results by date of publication or by title using the drop down menu.

Over 8,000 articles, books, and other resources can be found in the Library database.
