Need to find a treatment center for substance abuse/addiction and/or mental health problems?

SAMHSA's Behavioral Health Treatment Services

<u>Locator</u> can help locate facilities in your area. Facility types include substance abuse, mental health, health care centers, buprenorphine physicians, and veteran's affairs.

Search the locator using an address, city, state or zip code. A helpful locator map is provided in the search results. A search can be narrowed by several choices including type of care, service setting (outpatient, residential, inpatient, etc.), special programs offered, age groups accepted, payment type accepted, availability of payment assistance, and language.

The 4-minute <u>video tutorial</u> on using the locator is helpful.
