## ADHD Resource Corner



The **Library Catalog** of the NRC Library has migrated to the cloud-based Inmagic GeniePlus integrated library system.

Users of the catalog will experience fast and relevant search results, have the ability to email and print (in pdf or csv formats) their search results, access many articles in full-text, and find nearby academic libraries that may have an item of interest in their collections.

### The system features include:

- (1) Faceted search results that automatically refine by audience, material/record type, authors, subjects and serial titles;
- (2) Book cover images that link to Google books where one can read book reviews or portions of the book (when provided);
- (3) Alerts of new resources added to the catalog;
- (4) Saved selected popular searches such as all Attention magazine articles, books for parents, children, educators, professionals, etc.;
- (5) Catalog home page searches passed on to WorldCat, the world's largest library catalog, which provides users-via their zip code-with a list of nearby academic libraries carrying the needed item in their collections; and
- (6) Catalog home page searches passed on to the U.S. National Library of Medicine's PubMed database that provides links to journal articles-many of them free online.
