### **Progress Report of the Affiliate Advisory Board (AAB)**

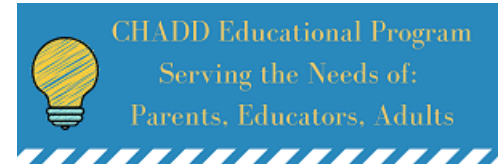
