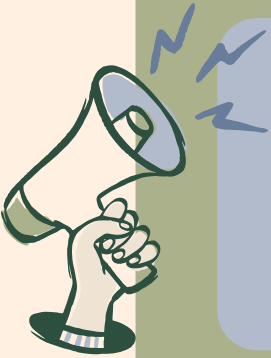


WERE YOU DIAGNOSED WITH ADHD IN ADULTHOOD?

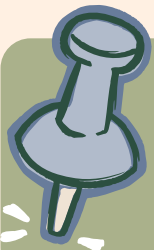
Requirements:

- Able to participate in a 60–90 minute virtual interview
- Able to speak and understand English
- Access to a private and secure location

Participation Includes:

- One 60–90 minute virtual interview (via Zoom) that will be audio/video transcribed
- Questions about your experiences before and after diagnosis
- Optional review of interview transcript to review for accuracy and completeness (about 15–30 minutes).
